AFT-NH is pleased to be offering the **Seventh Union Leadership Training** on May 10th. The training will focus on advocacy including grievance handling, the role of union leaders in the workplace and building a strong local union. The training will also focus on the most important task of mobilizing and engaging your membership. Even if you have attended past trainings you will benefit from this training. This is a great opportunity to interact with your colleagues from other AFT-NH locals and to learn from each other. Attendance at the training should be considered **essential** for local officers, negotiating team members, activists and building representatives.

The training will focus on building the power and strength of your local. There will also be training on representation, membership recruitment, promoting positive labor-management relations, member benefits and your role as a local Union Representative. As in prior trainings, guest speakers will be present.

There is a refundable registration fee of \$25 per person which will be refunded upon attendance at the training. The training will be held at the IBEW Union Hall in Concord.
